This quilt was made with Cake Mix Recipe 12 - Block 3.

#### Fabric Requirements:

1 Layer Cake of Dandi Annie

1 Bella Solid 9900 98 Layer Cake

1 3/4 yards Bella Solid 9900 98 for sashings and border - or 2 1/4 yards for a quilt that measures 68 1/4" x 79 1/8".

3/4 yard for binding

4 1/2 yards for Backing

8 7 6 5 4 3 2 1

**Cutting:**

From the Bella Solid, cut the following:

Cut 16 strips 1 ½" x 42" wof.

- From 8 of the strips, cut 30 rectangles – 1 ½" x 9 ⅞" - for the vertical sashing.
- Join the remaining strips end-to-end with a diagonal or straight seam. Press the seams open. From the long strip, cut 5 lengths - 1 ½" x 61 ¼" for the horizontal sashing.

Cut 7 strips 4" x 42" wof. Join the strips end-to-end with a diagonal or straight seam. Press the seams open.

From the length, cut the following:

- Side Outer Borders – cut 2 strips - 4" x 61 ¾"
- Top & Bottom Borders – cut 2 strips - 4" x 68 ¾"

**Assembly:** After stitching the Cake Mix Recipe grid - all seams are a scant ¼".

**Making the Blocks.** Layer 1 Dandi Annie print square and 1 Bella Solid background square – 10" x 10" – with right sides together. Make 36 pairs.

Pin one sheet of Recipe 12 paper on top of the lighter fabric - the Bella Solid square - with enough pins to secure the paper to the fabric while it is being turned and stitched. Then stitch on the dotted lines.

Cut the grids apart on the solid lines. Press the seams to the darker fabric with the paper still on. Remove the paper and trim the points.

Arrange the pieces as shown on the cover - Block 3. Sew the parts to make three rows. Press the seams toward the pieced-square segments.

- Our Dandi Annie blocks were made using three prints. Pair two sets of 2 matching HTSs, 1 set of 4 matching pieced segments and 1 background square.

Join the three rows to complete the block. Press the seams toward the center row - the pieced squares.

The block will measure 9 ⅞" x 9 ⅞". Make 36 blocks.

Lay out the blocks in six rows of six blocks each - alternating each block with one 1 ½" x 9 ⅞" sashing rectangle. Join the blocks and sashing strips to complete six rows. Press the seams toward the sashing strips.

Using the Outer Border strips pieced and cut earlier, join the side outer border strips - 4" x 61 ¾" - to the sides of the quilt top. Press the seams toward the outer border.

Now join the top and bottom outer border strips - 4" x 68 ¾" - to the top and bottom edges of the quilt top. Press the seams toward the outer borders.

Quilt and bind as desired.

**Larger Size?** The prints in the Dandi Annie collection are such that all 42 print squares have enough contrast with the background to allow making 42 blocks - seven rows of six blocks each. From the background, cut the following:

- Cut 4 more strips - 1 ½" x 42" wof. Cut 5 more vertical sashing rectangles and piece/cut 1 more horizontal sashing strip.
- Cut 1 more strip - 4" x 42" wof. Cut the Side Outer Borders - 4" x 72 ⅞".

A little bit more backing will also be required - add a ¼ yard for 4 ¾ yards total.
